Dear Mr. Carson:

It is a great pleasure to inform you that you have been selected as a Regents Scholar at the University of California, Los Angeles. Your appointment is for a three-year period beginning with the fall quarter of 1967.

Each Regents Scholar is selected on the basis of high scholastic achievement and promise without regard to his financial need. The stipend awarded to a Regents Scholar, if any, is designed to supplement his other resources so that he need not seek employment during the school year. In addition to this amount, each Regents Scholar receives an honorarium of \$100 at the beginning of each fall quarter in which he holds a Regents Scholarship.

The amount of the award which accompanies your appointment as a Regents Scholar is \$1,000 per academic year. Continued tenure as a Regents Scholar for the period of your appointment is subject only to the considerations set forth in one of the attachments to this letter.

You are asked to complete the enclosed form in order to confirm your appointment and return it to the Office of the Chancellor, Attention: Dean H. Carroll Parish, University of California, Los Angeles, no later than May 1, 1967. A public announcement of the awards will be made by the University on or about May 20.

Appointment as a Regents Scholar is one of the highest honors that can be conferred upon a student at the University of California. You are to be congratulated upon your achievements. We have every confidence that your work at the University will continue to demonstrate those qualities required for outstanding scholarship and for the assumption of civic responsibilities.
